



Step One: Login into the <u>Exhibitor Service Center</u> and add your booth Representatives to your Video Chat. For more information, please view our Video Chat Set Up Tutorial Video.

- Four reps permitted per booth
- All assigned reps need a JPG/PNG headshot (or company logo) which is 400px by 400px
- Be sure to include the TIME ZONE in which your representatives will be available
- You may name the rep by a person's name, or you can do by sales channel/product line/sales territories. See below for a sample from a company.
- Adding a video representative for video chats does NOT register them for the meeting.
 You must follow the instructions in your exhibitor registration task.

Backend Exhibitor Portal View:




Front End User Attendee View:




Step Two: After your representatives have been added, they will appear under "Video Conference with a Representative" as shown below.

You can either click the **blue Launch Video Chat** button to start the video chat on your computer, or click the **green Share Video Chat Link** button to copy the video chat link and share it with your representatives.







VIDEO CONFERENCE WITH A REPRESENTATIVE



Step Three: After clicking on Launch Video Chat, start your video chat by clicking the **blue Launch** button, as shown below.



Step 4: Be sure you are able to see the video chat Launch. Your screen should look similar to the picture below.




You can share the URL with anyone in your company to ensure you don't have firewall issues with accessing the video portal.

It is highly recommended you send this link to a colleague while you're in the room so you can test audio as well.



You may need to adjust your video settings by clicking the 3 dots in the lower right corner. Get familiar with this button to see all of the settings available to you.



Step 5: During the live event, when it comes time for your Sales Team Member(s) to enter the video chat, you can do one of two things:

1. Provide your Sales Team Members with YOUR username and access code to the Exhibitor Service Center to click the "Launch Video Chat" button pictured below.



2. Log in to the Exhibitor Service Center and click the "Launch Video Chat" button for each Sales Team Member, then copy the URL from the video chat window and send to the individual Sales Team Members.

FAQs

Can I change my Sales Team Members from one day to the next?

YES! Simply navigate back to this page, remove any Sales Team Members who are NOT going to be manning a video chat channel from the "Assigned Sales Team Member" list and add any new Sales Team Members by either adding them or clicking on a name from the "Available Sales Team Member" list.

How many people can be in each rep's video chat room?

12 people including any booth reps

Can we screenshare with the people in the video chat room?

Yes, simply click the desktop icon in the lower right corner.



Is there chat in the room?

Yes, click the talk bubble to open the chat.



Can the audience raise their hand?

Yes.
