Graduate Education Fellowship Grant recipients receive \$50,000 USD per year for two consecutive years.

SLAS Innovation Award

The SLAS Innovation Award is a \$10,000 (US) cash prize recognizing the work behind one exceptional podium presentation at the annual SLAS International Conference and Exhibition.

The award honors exceedingly innovative research that contributes to the exploration of technologies in the laboratory, exceeds a benchmark or milestone in screening or the lead discovery process, or demonstrates an advanced and integrated use of mature technologies.

SUBMISSION PERIOD:

Annually, May – September



SLAS Tony B. Academic Travel Awards

Students, graduate students, post-doctoral associates and junior faculty (less than four years in first academic appointment) are encouraged to apply for this travel award to help with certain travel expenses needed to attend the SLAS International Conference and Exhibition or the SLAS Europe Conference and Exhibition. Abstract submission and acceptance are required.

SELECTED RECIPIENTS RECEIVE:

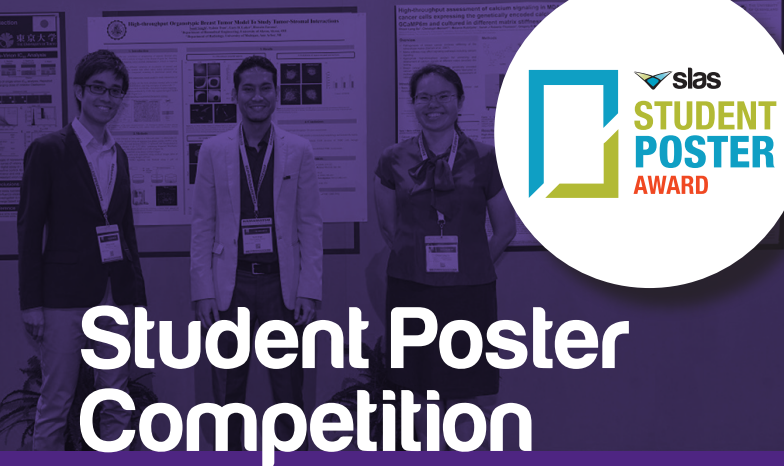
- Transportation costs (subject to SLAS policy),
- full conference registration,
- one short course registration
- and accommodations for a maximum of four nights in a shared room (two people per room).

Annually, May – September (Podium abstracts),
May – October (Poster abstracts)

SUBMISSION PERIOD FOR THE SLAS EUROPE CONFERENCE AND EXHIBITION:

Annually, December – February (Podium abstracts),
December – March (Poster abstracts)
